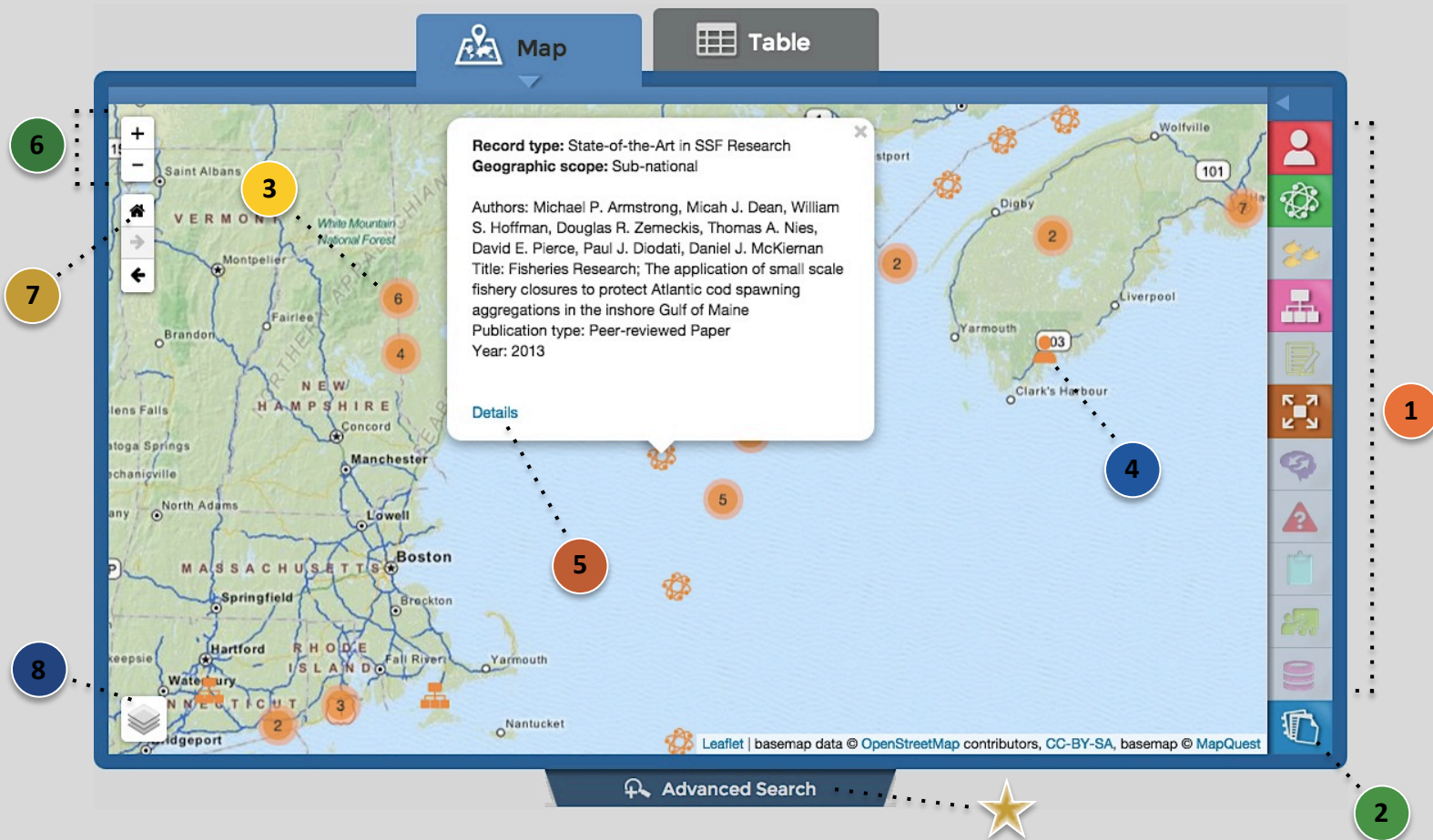

Section 1

The Homepage

1.1 The Map



- 1 Filter displayed data by dataset type
 - 2 Show/Hide all datasets
 - 3 Represents number of records at the location, clicking will expand to display all records
 - 4 Symbols correspond to the **dataset type** on the right, clicking a symbol will cause an information bubble to appear
 - 5 Redirects users to the record's **main page** which offers additional information
 - 6 Zoom in and out of the interactive map
Hint: Use the wheel of your mouse or double click to achieve the same result
 - 7 Return to the map's **original** zoom setting
 - 8 Select alternate **basemaps** and **overlays**
- ★ Reveal the Advanced Search panel


